The Vet farm is located on a 375 acre piece of land in Kanyariri village of Lower Kabete. It is 2 KM to the west of Upper Kabete campus and 15 KM from Nairobi city astride the Fort Smith Road, bordering the historical Fort Smith itself. The farm keeps a herd of dairy cattle, a flock of dorper sheep, a piggery unit and layer poultry unit. The farm is mainly a teaching facility in the faculty of Veterinary Medicine and faculty of Agriculture.
